Application process	<p>After nomination students will receive an email for the application process.</p> <p>Application period: Autumn Term: 15th July Spring Term: 1st February</p>
Updates	<p>We accept incoming students according to our bilateral agreements.</p> <p>Upon accepting a student, we will promptly send the Letter of Acceptance to the student and their Erasmus office. This formal document marks the beginning of their journey with us.</p> <p>Following the acceptance, we kindly request the student to create their Learning Agreement through the OLA platform at https://learning-agreement.eu/.</p> <p>To streamline the administrative process, we will digitally sign the Learning Agreement, ensuring a secure and efficient agreement process.</p>
Decision	<p>Letters of acceptance will be sent within 4 weeks after application deadline by email to the students and their coordinators.</p> <p>Students receive an E-mail with extensive information once they have been accepted.</p>
